Guidelines for Development of Quizzes

The Institute of Lifelong Learning (ILL) proposes to develop a large number of original quizzes in various disciplines for undergraduate courses which will facilitate an in-depth understanding of various topics through problem solving.

There will be three levels of quizzes namely: Level I ; Level II and Level III in increasing order of difficulty. Each faculty member will be required to develop questions whose breakup would be as follows : Level I (40%); Level II (40%) and Level III (20%).

The nature of questions of these quizzes can be as follows :

1. MCQs (with one or more than one option correct)
2. Matching Type (4 combinations constituting one question)
3. True or False (4 statements constituting one question)
4. Fill- in- blanks (4 fillings constituting one question)
5. Short questions (to test knowledge, understanding and /or application)
6. Numerical problems
7. Or any other type as approved by the subject reviewer/coordinator.

These questions will also be supported by justification of correct answers as well as the justification of why the answer is wrong. The spirit behind this is that students should also learn even from their mistakes.

The remuneration for developing these kinds of quizzes will be as follows:

1. Level I – Rs. 40/- per question
2. Level II – Rs. 60/- per question
3. Level III – Rs. 80/- per question

The above remuneration includes typing charges. The quizzes will be reviewed by the experts.

The decision of the reviewer in respect of inclusion/ deletion/ modification/ determination of difficulty level of the quiz will be final.
