3. The financial and administrative rules of the University of Delhi shall be applicable for all purchases, including travel for field-work.
4. Clearance of the animal ethical and institutional biosafety committee shall be mandatory wherever required. However, the PI(s) may submit an undertaking if such a clearance is not required in the research project.
5. The PI/Co-PI shall mandatorily submit an undertaking that they are not proceeding on any leave of more than six-month duration and have at least three years of service left in the university.
6. The Final Technical Report (FTR), along with the consolidated UC and SE, is essential for the successful completion of the project.
