With a teaching experience of nearly two decades, she holds a lot of literary accomplishments in her profile. After getting the paper- "Cartographic Education", published in Indian Cartographer, Vol.16, December 1996, her journey of contributing to the field of Cartography has seen no bounds. Under the aegis of Publications Division, University of Delhi, she authored 'India : Urban Tourism Systems' in 2001. Since the year 2005, she has been a member of Textbook Committee for Geography at NCERT for the geography books of Classes VI, VII & VIII. She undertook research in various parts of the country before completing her doctorate on 'Urbanisation and Tourism in India-A Spatio-structural analysis'. She submitted project to University Grants Commission on 'Pattern and Trend of Micro-Climatic Changes in Shimla and its impact on Tourism'. Several studies such as 'Socio-economic Impacts of Tourism in the Periyar Wild life Sanctuary' in 1995, 'Dynamics and Impact of Tourism on socio-economic-cultural environment' in 2001, 'Significance of tourism in the fragile mountain ecosystems' in 2004 were also undertaken by her through field research. Dr. Anshu also presented a paper on 'Gender Issues in Spatial Tourism Planning' at School of Planning and Architecture in 1998. With assistance from UGC and Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Govt. of India, she organised National Workshop on 'Food Security in India: Problems and Prospects' in 2008 at Kirori Mal College, University of Delhi. She has submitted major UGC financed project on 'Planning, Management and Development of Tourism in Bihar in 2011'.
