Department of Computer Science.

The Department of Computer Science began the academic year 2016-17 with the motto, 'Dream, Believe and Make it Happen'. The department took initiative to organize a number of academic and co-curricular activities throughout the year which witnessed a wide participation from students of Computer Science as well as other disciplines.

In the month of June, we added ten new Linux based i7 desktop computers to our Computer Science Laboratory. This was followed by forming a team of student members for 'The Computer Prodigies', the Computer Science Society with Nishant Chahar as President and 12 members. On 5th September, 2016, students celebrated Teacher's Day, where they facilitated the teachers followed by an informal interactive session of teachers and students. September 2016 ended with a seminar on 'Ethical Hacking' in which the students of various departments learnt about different types of hacking and different techniques of hacking.

In October 2016, a seminar on 'Web Development' was conducted. The students were informed about the methods of website development and publishing their own website. One of our students, Anirudh Krishnadas developed an Android/iOs based App, 'KMC-Connect'. It was launched in the presence of our Principal, many Senior Faculty members and students. The App provides students with all the information regarding our College. In January 2017, there was a talk on 'New Scopes and Horizons in IT', providing information to students regarding the future scope of IT and its career prospects. In February 2017, 'The Computer Prodigies' organized the technical festival, 'Technival 1.0', which was inaugurated by Dr. Sanjeev Singh, Institute of Informatics & Communication, University of Delhi, South Campus, and Mr. Sujit Kumar, Founder & Evangelist at RedDrop365.org. It carried out a series of activities and competitions for two consecutive days.

The various events included Innovation Summit, Tech Quiz, TechHunt, Word Brawl, LAN gaming, Code JAM and Gully cricket. Two of our final year students received an offer letter from Mahindra Comviva, an IT company for the position of 'Associate', through the Placement Cell of our college. The aim of the teachers—Mrs. Geethanjali Kher, Dr. Mamta Sareen and Shikha Jain—has been to keep the students at par with today's technology and help them develop their overall personality.

Department of Geography,

Redefining its standards by maintaining its legacy and past reputation, the Department of Geography established its tangible presence in the College and the University, creating a position of being a benchmark setter. The first event to enshrine this successful year was the Freshers' Welcome. The students got an avenue to converse and build healthy associations with the department and their fellowmates. Following on the tradition, the Department celebrated the Teachers' Day on the same day with great fervour and joy marking the selfless services of the Professors at large. The department conducted election in August, 2016 to elect the office bearers of the Geography Association, 2016-17.

The Department went on its first educational field trip of the curriculum year from 22nd to 29th September, 2016 to Himachal Pradesh covering areas of Kangra, Kullu, Manali, Dharamshala, Kasol, Manikaran etc. The trip was organised for the final year students to conduct survey on the various social, cultural, political & environmental aspects of the Himachal Pradesh. The trip proved to be very interactive and full of adventures. From trekking to exploring villages & markets, it was a great memorable trip for the students.

The second Field-Trip of the session was organised for the sophomores to conduct survey on various political & geographical aspects in Himachal Pradesh and Punjab. One survey was conducted in and around Dalhousie and Khajjiar including some villages therein. On the last leg of the trip to Amritsar, students visited Wagah Border, Golden Temple, Jillianwalabag, etc.and returned with lots of memories to cherish.

The most ambitious endeavour the Department undertook in the form of its Annual Fest 'GEOTIME' was organised on 16th & 17th February, 2017 with central themes of Food Security, Child Labour & Malnutrition. The grand event marked the presence of Shri D. K. Himanshu, Under Secretary, and Ministry of Labour & Employment. During the course of two days, various events such as the prestigious K. K. हिंदी संगोष्ठी का अगला कार्यक्रम 08 फरवरी (आधुनिक सभ्यता का संकट और प्रसाद साहित्य) विषय पर आयोजित किया गया इस कार्यक्रम की पहली वक्ता के रूप में प्रो. सुधा सिंह जी ने प्रसाद जी के साहित्य में मध्यम वर्ग की 'आशावादिता' पर प्रकाश डाला तथा प्रेमचंद के साहित्य से उसकी तुलनात्मक विवेचना भी की। कार्यक्रम की अगली शृंखला में डॉ. मधु वर्मा ने बताया की भारतीय संस्कृति और सभ्यता के मूल्य बोध को बचाने में जो प्रसाद जी ने हमें साहित्य दिया उसकी भूमिका अतुलनीय है। कार्यक्रम की अगली शृंखला में प्रो. ओमप्रकाश जी ने अपने अध्यक्षीय भाषण में बताया कि प्रसाद जी का साहित्य भारतीय जनमानस में व्याप्त गुलामी से टकराता है और हमें आगे बढ़ने की प्रेरणा देता है। इसी क्रम में इस कार्यक्रम के सबसे वरिष्ठ वक्ता के रूप में डॉ. राजेंद्र प्रसाद कृष्ण ने सबका धन्यवाद ज्ञापन करते हुए कार्यक्रम का समापन किया।

Department of Statistics

With poem recitals, music performances, special gifts along with a cake shaped in a scientific calculator, the students made their best efforts to make the day special for their teachers.

In October 2016, the department organized an Excursion to Manali. The six day trip was full of fun and resulted into an eventful experience for the students as well as the teachers. The students stayed at Snow Touch Resort, next to river Beas. A visit to the Mall Road, Manikaran Gurudwara and Hadimba Temple; a day trek in Parvati Valley, DJ night and bonfire night all were some other highlights of the trip.

In the second semester, the Department held an Intra-Departmental Cricket Tournament in association with UST in the College Activity Centre on 12th January, 2017. This event filled with zeal and enthusiasm continued for three days wherein students from all the three years participated in different teams and won prizes worth Rs. 4000 /-. Together, the Department made this session a vigorous, flourishing, and an inspiring year.

Department of Zoology

The students and Faculty members of the Department of Zoology welcomed the new batch on 19th July 2016 when the Freshers' were given a brief introduction about the College, Department and its related activities in the Orientation Program by the Teacher-in-charge Dr. Anita KamraVerma. Once the new batch became familiar with their seniors, the date for the Student Council Election 2016-17 was notified. Elections for the Zoology Student Council were peacefully held under the supervision of the Staff Advisors: Dr. Anjali Priydrshani, Dr.Haren Ram Chiary, Dr. Amod Kumar, and Dr. Kapinder as election Observers. Council members were selected based on their respective vote share.

The Freshers' Party was organized with great pomp and show on 23rd September, 2016. The event meant a formal welcome to the first year entrants by the seniors. The theme of Freshers' party was 'Black and White' and Freshers' were dressed accordingly. Jovial smiles and high spirits marked the welcome party for the students.

It provided the students a euphoric platform to exhibit their talent in a wide variety of cultural events. The party was celebrated with great fun and enjoyment to generate the feeling of fraternity among the juniors and seniors. The audience was kept enthralled by mind blowing performances like paper dance, songs, mimicry, followed by the most awaited event—the selection of Mr. Fresher and Miss Fresher contest. Mr. Yash and Miss Mahima were crowned as Mr. and Miss Fresher respectively.

The inaugural function of the Department for the academic session 2016-2017 was held on 27th September, 2016, wherein, Prof. Shweta Saran from Department of Life Science, Jawaharlal Nehru University gave a lecture on 'Interesting Experiments in Developmental Biology'. The lecture gave students an insight about various scientists and their remarkable work in the field of developmental biology. The lecture was followed by a Workshop, 'Dictyosteliumdiscoideum- A Model System for Developmental Biology'. The life cycle of D. discoideum was shown practically via slides. It is justified as a good model system for studying gene knock-out, gene knockin, restriction enzyme mediated mutagenesis allowing a wide range of biological questions to be tested. The workshop gave students a hands-on experience in handling live culture. The workshop was well attended by students from other science departments too.

Our department believes not only excelling in academics but also strengthening themselves physically and emotionally. After all, 'All work and no play make Jack a dull boy'. An Intradepartmental Cricket Match was also organized on 19th January, 2017. All the players were dressed in their departmental T-shirts. Competing teams played exceptionally well and no one was able to speculate the winning team till the end. The final year students won the first match and maintained their record by winning the second match. The third match was won by the first year students and all the winning teams rejoiced as they received the cash price of thousand rupees.

The students of the third year went for an Educational trip to National Dairy Research Institute (NORI) & National Bureau of Animal Genetic Resources (NBAGR) on 3rd February 2017, accompanied by Dr. Anjali Priyardarshani and Dr. Haren Ram Chiary. The trip was an effort to enable students to develop understanding of their course related critical topics especially to understand R&D and HRD related programs along with the tools and techniques employed in biotechnology.

ICAR-NBAGR, being a national accredited government institution, had a mandate to Identification, Evaluation, Characterization, Conservation and sustainable Utilization of Livestock and Poultry Genetic Resources, and Coordination and capacity building in animal genetic resources management and policy issues was a logical choice for the students pursuing Biotechnology. This visit was instrumental in creating awareness among students regarding the different courses offered by these institutes to enable them to make informed career choices to pursue Masters or Research programmes.

The 'Biocenose' society of the Department of Zoology organized a Two day Academic festival titled 'Ecydysis' 2017 on 22nd & 23rd February, 2017. There were four departmental festivals clashing on the same dates but still our festival witnessed a huge turn out from participants assembling from different departments and colleges. The first day started with an interesting lecture by Professor T. R. Rao, former Head of Department, Environmental Science and Advisor, IISER Mohali on 'Co-evolution'. His exceptional oratory skills enthralled the audience by his content coupled with humour. He entire audience was mesmerized with his aura. Keeping the interest of students in mind, a variety of entertaining events was organized such as Dental Consultancy, Gully Cricket, Lemon Race, Slow Cycling, General Quiz, Treasure Hunt and many more. A successful festival attracted as many as one hundred registrations. The winners were distributed cash prizes.

Under the auspices of Science Setu, the students visited AIIMS, New Delhi on 24th February, 2017 to attend a lecture in the Seventh Annual Cell Press—TNQ India Distinguished Lectureship Series by Nobel Laureate, Prof. Mary-Claire King, from ther University of Washington. Prof. Mary-Claire King had pioneered the idea that breast cancer could be a heritable disease. Professor along with her colleagues pinpointed a gene, BRCA1, which carries mutation that dramatically increase a women's risk of developing breast or ovarian cancer during her lifetime. The lecture was very interesting and gave us an exposure to scientific world as well as information about inheritable cancer, gene mutation and much more.

The students of B.Sc. (Hons) second year went on an educational trip to Bhubaneshwar where they attended an exposure programme on 'Aquarium Fish Keeping and Breeding' under SkiX Enhancement Course of CBCS, University of Delhi at the Ornamental Fish Breeding and Culture Unit, ICAR-CIFA, Bhubaneshwar on 20th & 21st March, 2017. They were accompanied by Dr. Lukram and Dr. Helionthous. The Chief Scientist CIFA, Dr. Saroj Swain, enlightened them about the practical aspects of fish culture. A lecture on the importance of breeding ornamental fish, preparation of fish-feed and other applied techniques was detailed, foxowed by a visit to the CIFA aquarium. The aquarium had live indigenous varieties of ornamental fish in abundance that could be cultured for economic benefits. They were given certificates at the end of the programme.

'B.A. Programme Society'

The B.A. Programme is one of the oldest and the most well known courses in Delhi University. The course is an amalgamation of various disciplines which ensures a holistic and well rounded academic experience with the scope of pursuing specialization in various disciplines, not being restricted to one particular stream.

The 'B.A. Programme Society' ensures that all the advantages and perks of this course are reaped by the students through various academic and non academic events. The year 2016-17 has been an active year for the Society by organising various seminars, talks and other activities throughout the year.
