On 9 August 2017, volunteers organised cleanliness drive in premises of college. Volunteers along with fellow college students dedicated their whole day for cleaning the college.








as well as a member of the National Executive Committee member of the Aam Aadmi Party. He was the Chief Guest of opening ceremony on 17th February 2018.
