Memorandum of Understanding

Between

ST – IIT Bombay, and Kirori Mal College, University of Delhi, Delhi - 110007

This “Memorandum of Understanding” hereinafter referred to as ‘MOU’ is signed on this 17th day of February, 2020 between the following two parties:

ST- IIT Bombay- NMEICT, MHRD, Government of India

AND

Kirori Mal College, University of Delhi, Delhi - 110007, through its authorised representative

Each shall be referred to in this MOU individually as “Party” or collectively as “Parties”.

A. Objective

The primary objective of this MOU is to enable the parties to identify mutual collaboration opportunities bringing together the strength of ST-IIT Bombay and Kirori Mal College, University of Delhi toward capacity building skills and education aimed at enhancement of self-employment opportunities.

B. Areas of Collaboration

The ST-IIT Bombay spoken tutorial (ST-MOOCs program) and Kirori Mal College, University of Delhi will collaborate in any/all of the following proposed areas:

- i. IT skills software training program for students and teachers.
- ii. Job oriented courses for employable skills.
- iii. Certificates to successful participants (students, faculty and non-teaching staff) in collaboration with K.M. College.
- iv. Promoting self-employment opportunities for the students of the college.
- v. Any other activity that can be taken up to promote skill enhancement.

A. General Provisions

1. The parties agree that they shall use their best endeavours to execute the provisions of this MOU. As such, this MoU is non-binding in nature and can't be legally pursued.

2. None of these provisions of this MoU shall be deemed to constitute a partnership between the parties here to and no party shall have any authority to bind or shall be deemed to be agent to the other in any manner. A detailed implementation plan may be drawn up annually by both the parties under this Agreement.
3. This MOU shall become effective on and from the date of execution hereof and shall continue to be effective for three years. After this period, it may be extended by the parties based on mutual agreement in writing until it is rescinded. This MOU may be terminated by either party by issuing a one month prior written notice at any time during the validity of this MoU to the other party.
4. The MOU shall be revisited as and when needed by both the parties with a view to the scope of the same.
5. Kirori Mal College will pay Rs.200 per student and Rs. 500 per faculty member enrolled for the course to ST-IIT Bombay.

The ST-IIT Bombay and Kirori Mal College have set their respective hands and seal to these presents through their duly authorised representatives on the date mentioned herewith.
