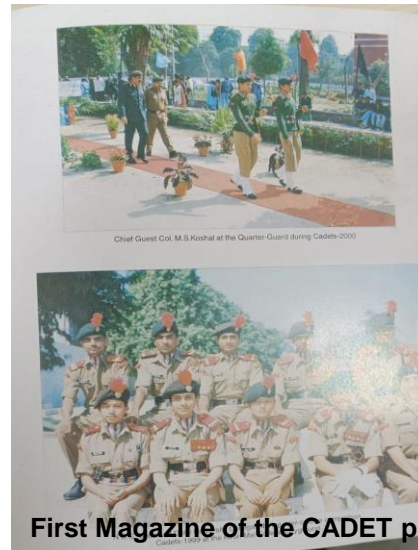
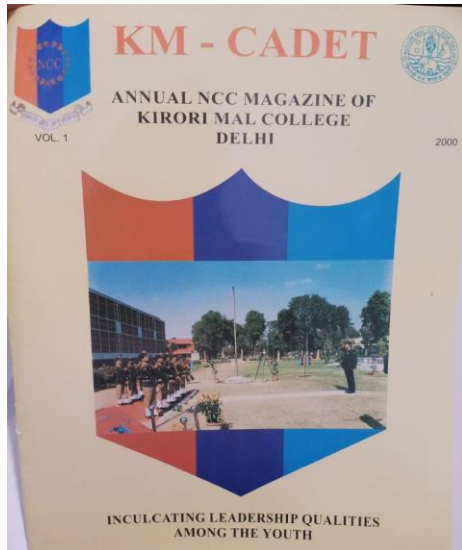

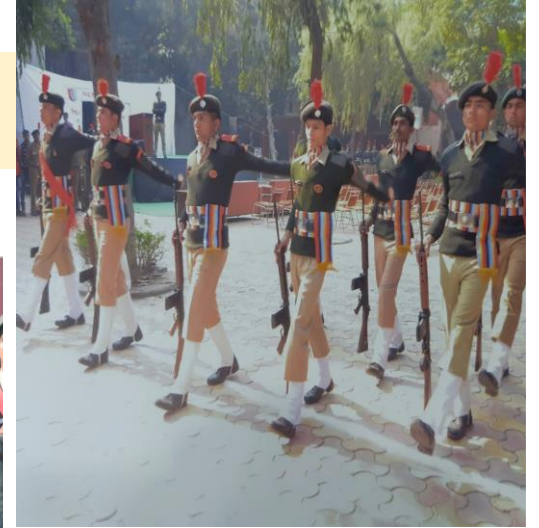
1. **SQUAD DRILL** : Both girls and boys team participated in the event from various institutes including college and school teams. Girls performed on the same drill commands as boys.


