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

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

The above graph depicts the Vital Few as per the 80/20 rule. There are 6 criteria which falls under the Vital Few and causes the 80% problems. The rest are the Trivial Many which causes the rest 20% problems. The above highlighted (in yellow) causes will be analyzed by each department through the 5 Why Quality Tool to find out the root cause of the problems and brainstorming session will be conducted on them. The Root Causes will be further analyzed to find out the possible solutions/workarounds and then the improvisation methods will be implemented upon them.
