### **ANNUAL REPORT (AUGUST 2023- JUNE 2024)**

National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Kirori Mal College (KMC), functioning under the University of Delhi under the **Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS)**, consistently strives to fulfil motto of NSS "Not Me, But You" through its projects **SAHYOG** and **SAHAS**.

**Sahyog**, meaning "cooperation" , focuses on child empowerment. Under this project NSS volunteers conduct "**Each One Teach One**" (EOTO) sessions for students from nursery to class 12 from their adopted **village, Chandrawal**. These sessions go beyond academics, incorporating play activities and holistic development initiatives. Additionally, online classes are provided for students unable to attend offline sessions, including those preparing for board exams and the Central Universities Entrance Test (CUET).

**Sahas**, translating to "courage" in , focuses on **women's empowerment**. Through various activities, NSS volunteers work diligently towards achieving this goal.

Initially, around 100 volunteers were recruited for this term. A strength of 60-70 volunteers worked as volunteers throughout the year.

## **RAKSHABANDHAN CELEBRATION**




## **G20 UNIVERSITY CONNECT FINALE**

## National Youth Week



NSS-KMC under **Yuvaah'24** organ a **creative writing competition** for their college students to showcase their writing skills.




## UPSC Speaker Session

## **Vasant Panchami Celebration**




## Kavi Sammelan


Volunteers of NSS KMC, compassionately fed street dogs, cows, planted trees, and provided water to the plants and birds, showing care for all beings.
